For nine days and nine nights we will visit **six** beautiful ports of the Caribbean and the Yucatán of Mexico. We will have a full day at the island of Cozumel in Mexico, Costa Maya, Harvest Caye, Belize and Roatán, Bay Islands, Honduras. Two additional ports of call include George Town, Grand Cayman and Santo Tomás de Castilla in Guatemala.

The best part of the trip is that Golden Frontier has been able to secure the cruise, plus your transportation to and from New Orleans, meals on the ship and en route, and entertainment for twelve days for as low as \$1,785.00 per person.

All documents must be returned before a refund can be processed. **Once application is made, all cancellations are subject to a non-waivable \$150.00 per person cancellation fee.** Written cancellations received in Golden Frontier's office 91 to 36 days prior to departure forfeit \$500.00 per person. Cancellations 35 to 15 days prior to departure forfeit 50% of total payments. Cancellations 14 days or less prior to departure forfeit 100% of total payments. Golden Frontier shall not be obligated to refund any portion of a fare for a passenger who must leave the cruise prematurely for medical or other reasons. The cruise ticket is valid only for the named passenger and may not be sold or transferred. **Optional trip cancellation and baggage insurance** is available for those who desire. Insurance can cover cancellation of your reservation prior to departure, leaving the tour after departure, baggage loss, and some medical coverages.
